Dear Sir:-

Agreeable to your request I submit the following proposal, to furnish the labor and materials required for the following enumerated work at your residence at Newport.

- 1st. Storm Shutters on First Floor: all windows in Salon, Sitting Room, Library, Dining Room, closing Arches under Loggia, and Storm Door, at Front Door.
- 2nd. Storm Shutters on Second Floor: windows in Mrs. Goelet's Room, Mr. Goelet's Room, continuing on Second Floor, all windows, on the East and North fronts, to Servants wing, as far as and including the windows over Dining Room Bay.
- 3rd. Storm Shutters on Third Floor: all windows in room over Mr. and Mrs. Goelet's rooms.
- 4th. Boxing in Four Lamps, at Webster Street entrance; Six columns, with Vases, Lamps, etc. in Court at West of house.
