Registration for the continuing education courses of second semester at Salve Regina College will take place in the Registrar's Office, second floor of Ochre Court, Friday, January 27, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

The continuing education program of the College is designed to meet the needs of men and women. Credit courses are offered for renewal of teaching certificates, for strengthening background and for developing new interests. Preparation for teachers of the mentally retarded is offered through an organized continuing education program of special education. Courses will fulfill the needs of high school graduates and others who have completed some or all of their college credits. Advanced work in specialized areas for professional men and women is also provided.
