Sister Mary Cleophas, R.S.M., Ph.D., President of Mt. St. Agnes College, Baltimore, Maryland for fifteen years until her recent retirement, will be guest lecturer at Salve Regina College, Newport on Sunday, July 14. Currently director of an NDEA Institute for Applied Linguistics in Baltimore, Sister Cleophas was named Outstanding Woman of the Year in 1966 by the Baltimore Business and Professional Women's Association. She is the first Roman Catholic sister to be invited to theological discussions at Princeton University Theological Seminary and has served on the Baltimore Archdiocesan Council.

The lecture, "The Forgotten Strand of Teaching," will be held on Sunday, July 14 at 4:00 P. M. in the Great Hall of Ochre Court on Ochre Pt. Ave. The public is cordially invited to attend.

A former student and assistant to Charles Schulz, creator of the "Peanuts" comic-strip, Rev.
