Health Fair at Salve

Immediate release of broadcast

Student nurses at Salve Regina College in Newport are sponsoring a two-day Health Fair on February 7-8 from 11 A.M. to 8 P.M. in Angelus Hall on the college campus. "Knowledge Replaces Fear" is the theme of this first such program undertaken by the Student Nurses Organization, and its purpose is to provide the lay person with information concerning health including the cause and prevention of disease. Demonstrations, discussions, films, and literature will cover such areas as nutrition, maternal and child health, mental health, first aid, disaster care, cancer, heart disease, tuberculosis, and strokes. A Chest Mobile will be on campus providing free chest x-rays and there will also be diabetes testing available.

Highlight of the Fair will be an address by Dr. Harold Musiker, Director of Psychology at R. I. Hospital, on "Stresses of College Life." Dr. Musiker will speak on Wednesday, February 7 at 11:00 A. M. in O'Hara Academic Center.
