HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENTS

DR. FELIX DE WELDON

DOCTOR OF FINE ARTS

Dr. de Weldon was born in Vienna, Austria where he obtained his early education. He holds a Ph.D. from the University of Vienna; Academy of Creative Arts and School of Architecture, Vienna, Austria where he specialized in sculpture and painting. He also studied in Rome and Florence, Italy, Oxford, England, and under Bourdello in Paris, France. He has traveled extensively through Greece, Egypt, Palestine, India, Maylasia, Thailand, Japan, Syria and Africa studying the art of these countries. Dr. de Weldon served in the U. S. Navy during World War II and is a member of the President's Commission of Fine Arts. He is a former member of the Salve Regina College Board of Trustees. Among his numerous works is "The Flag Raising on Iwo Jima" (U. S. Marine Corps War Memorial) in Washington, D. C.

Sister Mary Concilia Moran, R.S.M. Doctor of Humane Letters Sister Mary Concilia Moran is Administrator General of the Sisters of Mercy of the Union in the United States of America, a position she has held since 1971. Sister Concilia received a bachelor of science degree in nursing from the College Misericordia in Dallas, Pennsylvania and a master of science degree in nursing from Marquette University in Wisconsin. She is chairperson of the Region IV Leadership Conference of Women Religious and of the Board of Incorporators at Mercy Hospital in Johnston, Pennsylvania. Sister Concilia is also a member of the Board of Directors of the Women's Coalition for Third Century, the Board of Incorporators of Mt. Aloysius Junior College in Cresson, Pennsylvania, and the Executive Council of the Federation of the Sisters of Mercy of the Americas.

THE HONORABLE THOMAS J. PAOLINO

DOCTOR OF LAWS

Judge Paolino, Associate Justice of the Rhode Island Supreme Court received his A.B. degree from Brown University and his LL.B. from Harvard Law School. He was admitted to the Rhode Island bar in 1931 and the federal bar in 1932. In 1956 he was elected to the Supreme Court of the State of Rhode Island by unanimous vote of the General Assembly sitting in Grand Committee and was sworn in as an Associate Justice of the court. He is still an active member of this court. He holds honorary degrees from Bryant College in Providence, Rhode Island, St. Francis College in Biddeford, Maine, and Suffolk University Law School in Boston, Massachusetts.
