"New Visions for Newport County" will conduct a two-day conference for social service and community action agencies on August 22 and August 23, utilizing O'Hare facilities.

The Association of Teachers of Mathematics in New England (ATMNE) will hold their twenty-sixth annual institute here, from August 18 to August 23. They will meet in O'Hare, and reside in Miley.

On August 22 - 23, the Newport County Youth Consultation board of directors will sponsor a conference here entitled "Drug Abuse/Education is a Large Part of the Answer."

Lt. Governor J. Joseph Garrahy is to be the keynote speaker. Professor R. F. Delaney, of the U. S. Naval War College, and Dr. Lowell Levin, of Yale University's Health Services Department, are also expected to address the group.

Registration may be accomplished in person on the first day. Registration fee is \$2.00 for 18 years and over, under 18, no cost.
