Mr. B. Cowles Mallory, the Newport City Manager, spoke to the state and local government class Wednesday morning, March 12, at Salve Regina College. Mr. Mallory outlined the origin and development of the council-manager form of government in the U.S. He noted that efficiency and the separation of policy and administration were important factors in the setting up of the manager form of government. However, he noted the need for any form of government to be responsive to the desires of the people.
