The current is fed to all lights from the closet in the room of Miss Goelet; one switch controlling the lights in both rooms. This switch should never be touched. In order to light the chandeliers turn on small switch in above named closet, to put out same, turn off same switch.

To light the lamps on both sides of the bed in room of Mrs. Goelet, turn the small switch at the right side of door, on entering. The light on left side of bed ~~can~~ be turned off by the switch directly under the lamp.

The lights are controlled in the room of Miss Goelet, by a switch on the outside of the entrance, and by another switch situated by the side of the bed.
