At the regular meeting of the Salve Regina College Board of Trustees, Monday, November 30, representatives of the College Council and the Faculty Welfare Committee of the Faculty Senate -- two groups who had requested at short notice the opportunity to address the Board -- were invited to sit with the Board at different times during the meeting in order to continue discussion of their respective problems, namely, the requested approval of the Student Congress Bill of Rights and Responsibilities, and the "freeze" of all salaries at the College for the 1971-72 academic year.

Following brief discussion with the representatives of the two groups, the Board assigned the two issues to the appropriate Board committees for further clarification and discussion with the College Council and Faculty Welfare Committee. (The appropriate Board committees are the academic and student affairs committee -- Sr. Mary Olivia Barrett, R. S. M., Sr. Mary Christopher, R. S. M., The Rev. Cornelius B. Collins, and Dr. John F. Quinn, ex officio -- and the budget and finance committee -- Mr. Michael Gammino, Sr. Mary Christopher, Dr. I. George Schaffer, and Dr. Quinn, ex officio.

The representatives of the College Council at the Board meeting were Dr. Lester Carr, vice president for academic affairs; Dr. E. William Burrell, associate professor of English and education, and chairman of the education department; and Miss Carolyn M. Reder, president of the student congress at the women's college. Representing the Faculty Welfare Committee of the Faculty Senate were Mr. Warren Harrington, college librarian, and president of the Senate; Mr. Stanley Grashow, assistant professor of creative arts, and chairman of the department; Mr. Jesse W. McCoy, assistant professor of mathematics; and Miss Rae K. O'Neill, assistant professor of education.
