The glee clubs of Salve Regina College and St. Michael's College, Winooski, Vt., will sing a concert Saturday (Nov. 21) evening in the Great Hall of Ochre Court, Newport.

The combined concert, featuring the music for brass and chorus of Giovanni Gabrieli and Daniel Pinkham, will begin at 8 p.m. The public is invited free.

Gabrieli's "In Ecclesiis" and "Jubilate Deo," and Pinkham's "Christmas Cantata," performed by the combined choruses and a brass ensemble, will highlight the program.

The Salve Regina singers will open the concert with their renditions of Thomas Morley's "My Bonny Lass," Richard Winslow's "Huswifery," Arthur Honegger's "Trois Psaumes," and Jan Sweelinck's "Hodie Christus Natus Est."

The St. Michael's chorus will present Cesar Franck's "Psalm 150," Vittoria's "Ave Maria," Debussy's "Invocation," and Randell Thompson's "The Testament of Freedom," as well as a spiritual called "Every Time I Feel The Spirit," and selections from Frank Loesser's Broadway musical hit, Guys and Dolls.

Glenn Giuttari, Providence, will conduct the 44-voice Salve Regina glee club, while Dr. William Tortolano will lead the 42-man St. Michael's chorus.

Mr. Giuttari, now in his second year of conducting at the women's college, is a graduate student in musicology at Brown University, his alma mater.

Dr. Tortolano, also a native of Providence, was assistant organist at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral from 1950-1953, and organist and choir director at St. Anne's Church, Providence from 1956-1959.

Assistant conductor of the St. Michael singers will be Paul LeClair, while Mrs. Norma Auchter will be their piano accompanist.

Accompanists for the Salve Regina glee club will be Sister Marianne Postiglione, chairman of the music division of the creative arts department, and Miss Jeanne Roy, a senior from North Providence.

Although Saturday's program will be Salve Regina's first full concert of the season, the glee club did present a "mini-concert" during the College's recent Father-Daughter Dance on campus.
