Newport, R. I., April 8th 1897

Mr John Yale,
Dear Sir,

Regarding the stables:- While in some few places, such as the outside of horse stalls, two coats are required, it is my opinion that one good coat will be sufficient, & will make a first class job of the greater proportion of the surface requiring to be covered, consequently I send you my price for one good coat of Hard Oil on all the woodwork at present Hard Oiled, & one good coat of paint on all surfaces at present painted, said price to include bronzing pipes & gas brackets, & blacking all ironwork at present blacked.

I agree to give Carriage house, (excepting floor) Main Hallway, & Stalls, one (1) good coat of Hard Oil & one (1) good coat of paint, over surfaces at present Hard Oiled & Painted, for the sum of \$ 117 ⁰⁰/₁₀₀.

(One Hundred & Seventeen dollars.)

I further agree to give same treatment as above on Men's Wardrobe rooms & Toilet on

first floor, including lower story of staircase
entering same, for the sum of \$ 27⁰⁰/₁₀₀.

(Twenty seven dollars.)

I further agree to give same treatment to
Harness & cleaning rooms, for the sum of \$ 28⁰⁰/₁₀₀

(Twenty eight dollars.)

assuring you my personal supervision of the
