Dear Sir;

Referring to the correspondence which has passed in reference to the production of Owners Oaths on certain entries made at the Custom House for goods consigned to you, we must request that steps be immediately taken to procure the necessary cancellation of these bonds.

If we are unable to produce this evidence, we shall be under the necessity of paying out a large amount of money, which, naturally, you will undoubtedly object to, but as the matter is now in the hands of the District Attorney, they must either be closed by the production of the Owners Oaths or the payment of such sums as the District Attorney will take in cancellation of the above bonds.

There are so many of these now accumulated that we have been notified by the Collector of the Port that unless same are promptly cancelled, he will refuse to allow us to enter any more goods.
