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Motion to Amend the Process of Faculty Evaluation of Administrators

RATIONALE:

The Faculty Assembly voted in 2004 to institute an annual evaluation of academic administrators. At the Faculty Assembly meeting on February 3, 2006, President Antone said that while she welcomes faculty involvement in the evaluation of academic administrators the present process being used by faculty is not acceptable to her. President Antone offered to work with faculty to develop an acceptable process. President Antone suggested that the Faculty Assembly elect five members of the faculty to work with her and the consultant to develop a valid process.

MOTION:

As a Faculty Assembly, working in the spirit of cooperation with the administration, it is our will to hold in abeyance the annual administrative evaluations for one year and to hold an election of five faculty who will work with the President to develop a process for faculty evaluation of academic administrators. . Upon development of a mutually acceptable process, the elected group of faculty will bring the new process to the Faculty Assembly for a vote to implement it in spring 2007 in place of the current process.
