**BRISTOL MAN NEW BUSINESS MANAGER

Normand O. Ross of Bristol, R. I. has been appointed to the post of business manager at Salve Regina College. Announcement of Mr. Ross' appointment was made today by Sister Mary Christopher, R.S.M., College president.

A graduate of the University of Maryland (1966), Mr. Ross joins the Salve Regina administrative staff from the position of controller for Coronet Thermogravers, Inc., and previously management consultant for P. M. Providence, Inc., a management consultants firm.

He has served as administrative assistant for International Data Sciences, Inc., Providence; business analyst for Dun & Bradstreet, Providence; sales correspondent at Texas Instruments, Attleboro, Mass.; and commercial teller for the Plantations Bank of R. I., the latter previous to his enlistment in the U. S. Navy.

While in the Navy, from 1961 to 1966, Mr. Ross served as interpreter in Chinese, French, Italian and Spanish. He also worked in personnel and hospital administration. Education while in the service included the U. S. Yeoman School, Maryland; the U. S. Army Language School and the U. S. Navy Hospitalman School in Monterey and San Diego, California, respectively.

For the past five years, Mr. Ross has been operating his own management consulting firm, General Management Associates.

The new business manager has also completed three years towards a bachelor of science degree in Business Administration at Bryant College.

Mr. Ross and his wife, the former Lorraine Burns, reside with their five children at 10 Fernwood Road in Bristol.
