DR. PAUL ABEL - LECTURE

On Monday, February 23, 1981 at 7:00 pm in the T.B. room, the Departments of Chemistry and History/Political Science are sponsoring a lecture to be given by Dr. Paul Abel, Professor of Chemistry at the University of Rhode Island. The talk will be entitled "Climate and Early Man in Africa."

Dr. Abel is well known for his research work in organic lunar and terra geochemistry and the anthropological interpretation. He has worked for more than 14 years on expeditions in Boringo, Omo River, Koobi Fora, Olduvai Gorge and Lactobi with Richard and Mary Leakey, the noted anthropologists.

Scientific technical literature as well as "Scientific American" and "National Geographic" have published his works.

MEDICAL TECHNOLOGY CLUB

The Medical Technology Club of Salve Regina began their series of classes in CPR (cardio pulmonary resuscitation) February 18th and 19th. The courses are taught by Chief Petty Officer Harold Chenevert of the Naval Regional Medical Center, and are designed to train students in the emergency treatment needed by a cardiac victim.
