TWO NEW BOARD MEMBERS NAMED

J. Joseph Kruse and Sister Marie Andre Guay, R.S.M., both of Pawtucket, R.I., have been named to the board of trustees of Salve Regina - The Newport College, it was recently announced by chairman of the board, Jeremiah C. Lynch, Jr.

Mr. Kruse is a senior vice president at Textron Inc. in Providence. A native of St. Petersburg, Fla., he is a graduate of the University of Florida, Gainesville, and holds a master's degree from Florida State University.

Currently Mr. Kruse is vice chairman of the Brown University Medical School Fund Drive and will serve as chairman of the drive next year. He serves as a member of the board of several organizations including the Ocean State Performing Arts Center, Trinity Square Repertory Theatre, Providence Foundation, New England Council and the New England Board of Higher Education Commission on Higher Education and the Economy. He is also a board member and assistant treasurer of the United Way of South-eastern New England. Mr. Kruse is immediate past president of the R.I. Historical Society and immediate past chairman of the R.I. Catholic Charities Fund Appeal.

Sister Andre is the newly appointed superintendent of Catholic schools of the Diocese of Providence. She has served as assistant superintendent of the Diocese since 1978. Prior to this position, Sister Andre was principal of St. Xavier Academy in Providence for six years, provincial councilor for the Sisters of Mercy and principal of St. Mary Academy in East Providence from 1965-70. In addition to her school administration posts, Sister Andre taught in Providence and East Providence elementary and secondary schools for over 15 years.

She holds a B.Ed. from Catholic Teachers College (Providence) and an M.A. from Assumption College (Worcester, Mass.). She also attended graduate school at Laval University (Quebec) and is currently a CAGS candidate at Rhode Island College.

Sister Andre is a Member of the Corporation of both Salve Regina

College and St. Xavier Academy. She is also a member of the National Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development, the Title IV State Advisory Council, the National Catholic Education Association and Women Educators of Rhode Island.

Sister Andre has received an honorary doctor of pedagogy degree from Our Lady of Providence Seminary College, a distinguished service award from the Diocese of Providence, and a National Association of Secondary School Principals award as one of 60 most effective principals in the U.S.

NEW ASSISTANT DIRECTOR OF DEVELOPMENT NAMED

Janet Ellen Brown has been named to the new position of assistant director of development at Salve Regina - The Newport College by Sister M. Therese Antone, vice president of institutional advancement.

Prior to her appointment, Janet was a foundations analyst within the Office of Resource Development at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. She assisted in the implementation of a \$225M capital campaign foundation funding effort.

Other positions held by Janet at M.I.T. include administrative assistant for the Department of Civil Engineering and production assistant for the Office of Design Services. She has also worked as an assistant interior designer and draftsman.

At Salve, Janet will assist the director of development in planning, research and communication in the development program which includes corporate, foundation and individual gift programs. Responsibilities include researching, identifying and evaluating individual prospects, foundations and corporations, preparing all grant proposals, and developing a procedure for gift receipt, recording and follow-up of major grants and pledges.

Janet is a graduate of the Rhode Island School of Design, Providence, with a bachelor of fine arts degree. She is a native of Silver Spring, Maryland, but has lived in the Boston area for the past 11 years.
