### Specification for Granite Curbing from Robert M. Gill & Co.

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S P E C I F I C A T I O N

For supplying Granite Curbing according to plan and full size detail, supplied by Ernest W. Bowditch, Engineer, on the Estate of Mr. Ogden Goelet, at Newport, R. I.

The Granite Curb is to be of FitzWilliam Granite, as per sample deposited in the office of Ernest W. Bowditch, Engineer, and is to be cut according to details and plan, as per sample furnished.

The stone is to be free from all defects, of one average color, workmanship to be twelve (12) cut and of the best of its kind, cut to mould and to a true and level line; no stone to be less than six (6) feet in length, and the end left square at the bottom so that two (2) stones can rest on one brick pier for foundation.

Wherever there is an angle in the curb shown on the plan, said angle stone is to have a shoulder not less than six (6) inches in length, left or right .

Inspection. The stone is to be inspected by the Engineer or his representative, before shipment is made.

Boxing. The stone is to be protected by boxing before being shipped, and all stone damaged on arrival at Newport will be condemned by the Engineer.

Time . The stone is to be delivered at Newport on or before <sup>March 31<sup>st</sup></sup> ~~February 29<sup>th</sup>~~, 1896.

Price. The Granite Curbing is to be delivered on board the cars at Newport, for the sum of One Dollar and Forty Five cents (\$1.45) per foot, this price to include the shoulders hereinbefore mentioned.

The whole work is to be done to the entire satisfaction of Ernest W. Bowditch, Engineer.
