SALVE RECEIVES TWO MORE GRANTS FOR STATEWIDE CONFERENCE ON CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT

Two \$1,000 grants were recently awarded to Salve by the Textron Charitable Trust and Arthur Young and Company. The grants will help support a statewide conference on aspects of child abuse and neglect to be held April 3 at Salve.

The conference coincides with the last meeting of a six-week course (March 6- April 3) offered by Salve that is pilot testing a model curriculum on child abuse and neglect. Individual and group experiences from the workshop will be presented at the conference to other educational, law enforcement, medical, family and child protective agencies throughout Rhode Island.
