CONTINUE INTERPRETATION OF PAPAL ENCYCLICALS

On Monday, February ~~10~~¹⁷, at 3:30 p.m. the Salve Regina College faculty seminars will continue their study of the Pontificate of Pope John XXIII when Reverend Robert J. McEwen, S.J., head of the Boston College Economics Department will speak on "The Economic Aspect of the Encyclicals of Pope John XXIII." Past seminars have studied the social doctrines and the concepts of liberty and justice.

Father McEwen was originally scheduled to speak January 13 but the lecture was postponed due to the storm.
