Willis won his class at Connecticut meet. Gerald Willis of Newport and Salve Regina College won the 181-pound class en route to the outstanding lifter award in the first Connecticut Cup weightlifting competition Saturday at Bulkeley High School.

Willis had New England records of 292 pounds in the snatch and 369 pounds in the clean and jerk for a total of 661 pounds, which is his personal best.

Willis, a sophomore at Salve, competed against six others in the lightweight division.

The men's basketball team dropped three closely contested games to Babson, Roger Williams and Framingham.

The women's basketball team brought their record to 4-2, defeating the Coast Guard and Framingham and losing to Eastern Connecticut.
