Salve Regina College in Newport will hold its fourteenth annual Commencement on the Terrace of Ochre Court, the college's main building, on Monday, June 1 at 3:00 p. m. His Excellency, the Most Reverend Russell J. McVinney, D.D. will preside and Dr. William H. Conley, President, Sacred Heart University in Bridgeport, Conn. will address the graduates.

Honorary Doctor of Laws degrees will be bestowed upon the Very Reverend Vincent C. Dore, O.P., President of Providence College, and Dr. John Francis Quinn, Vice President of Student Affairs at the University of Rhode Island.

There will be 103 graduates at the Commencement, of whom 77 will receive A.B. degrees and 26 B.S. degrees. Fifty-seven students will receive Statements of Eligibility for Teaching. Twenty students have completed the Baccalaureate Degree Program in Nursing and two the Medical Technology Course.

Four graduates will be registered nurses who are the first to complete a Graduate Nurse program in any Rhode Island College. The program has only been recently approved by the National League for Nursing.

Sunday, May 31, has been designated as Baccalaureate Sunday. The graduates and their parents will attend Mass at St. Mary's Church, Newport at 4:30 p. m. The Baccalaureate Mass will be celebrated by Reverend John Martin Egan, O. P. , and the sermon will be delivered by Reverend Paul C. Curran, O. P. , of the Salve Regina faculty.

Following the Mass, a dinner for graduates and their parents, as guests of the college, will be held at the Shamrock Cliff Hotel at 6:00 p. m. Miss Sheila Carroll, 31 Stockholm St. , Newport, will be toast mistress.

On Saturday evening, May 30, at the Commencement Ball, Seniors and their escorts will dance to the music of the Richard Linson orchestra in the Great Hall of Ochre Court, from 9 to 1.
