KENNEDY SCHOLARSHIP WINNER ARRIVES AT SALVE REGINA COLLEGE

Miss Cecelia Chou Wing Wang, winner of the President Kennedy Memorial Scholarship for a Foreign Student established last year by the students of Salve Regina College, will arrive at the College Wednesday morning, October 7, 1964.

Miss Wang comes to this country from Selangor, Malaya. She graduated from the Kuen Cheng Girls' High School, Kuala Lumpur in Malaya, and last year studied at the National Chengchi University in Taipei, Taiwan, China.

She was met at Logan Airport in Boston Tuesday evening by Mrs. James McCabe of Edgewood, Rhode Island, a sister-in-law of the Rev. Edwin J. McCabe, M. M., the missionary priest who made the original contact between Miss Wang and the College.
