Fathers Council of Salve Regina College announced today the plans for the 1964 Father-Daughter Week End to be held at the college October 24-25.

The week end will start with a Coffee Hour in the Great Hall of Ochre Court, the college's main campus, on Saturday, October 24 at 9 a.m. Following this, dads and daughters will attend a series of regular classes, reduced in time to half periods, to enable fathers to observe the many changes that have taken place in college teaching since their days in school.

A buffet luncheon in the State Dining Room will be followed by general and area Fathers Conferences in Mercy and McAuley Halls, with the remaining part of the afternoon free for individual and group tours of the campus and Newport. Each of the four classes will hold a separate banquet in Newport hotels, followed by a dance at Ochre Court.

The week end will conclude Sunday morning with Mass in the DeLaSalle Academy gymnasium followed by breakfast at Cliff Walk Manor.

This will be the third of such Father-Daughter Week Ends at Salve Regina. Details are in charge of a local committee of members of the Fathers Council. About 250 father-daughter couples are expected.
