**SALVE REGINA PROFESSOR TO
PARTICIPATE IN PANEL DISCUSSIONS**

Mr. Robert J. McKenna, Assistant Professor of Social Studies and Philosophy at Salve Regina College, will participate in a panel discussion with Mayor Dennis Shea and City Manager Fred Weisbrod at a meeting of the St. Joseph's Holy Name Society, Sunday, April 17, 7:30 p.m., at the Clark Street Hall in Newport.

The discussion will cover the problems facing cities today.

Mr. McKenna, who was Special Assistant to Senator Claiborne Pell before coming to Salve Regina last fall, will also be a panelist at the National Catholic Educational Association New England Regional Meeting at Annhurst College, located in South Woodstock, Conn., April 23. The panel will discuss the subject, "Congressional Internship Programs."

Senator Pell's Internship Program has had over 250 students from Rhode Island take part in it since it was started in 1961. Mr. McKenna is coordinator of the program at Salve Regina College.
