SMALL FRY TO REIGN SUPREME AT OCHRE COURT
FOR SALVE REGINA ALUMNAE FAMILY DAY SUNDAY

The Great Hall of Ochre Court, the administration building of Salve Regina College, will resound with the laughter and chatter of over 100 happy children--sons and daughters of Salve Regina alumnae--Sunday afternoon, May 2, from 2:30 to 4:30 p. m.

The occasion is the annual Alumnae Family Day, one of the College's most riotous functions. Originally known as "Baby Day," this popular event has been outgrown by its former babies and of necessity has become a function to include the older children, too.

Representatives from the fourteen classes which have graduated from Salve Regina since 1951 are expected. For those unable to attend, a family album of pictures will be on display.

Students from the College's education and psychology departments will act as guides and baby sitters for the small fry, looking after a program of games and refreshments. This will allow the parents free time to revisit familiar scenes, as well as taking part in the public Open House at Miley Hall, the College's new student residence and student center, which is being held from 1:00 until 5:00 o'clock the same afternoon.
