SALVE REGINA COLLEGE WELCOMES
NEW FRESHMAN CLASS

Two hundred and three freshmen
were welcomed to Salve Regina College this morning by Sister Mary Emily, R. S. M.,
President. They are representative of 100 cities in 12 states.

The freshmen will be housed in
Miley, Queen, and Mercy Halls.

The arrival of over 100 resident
students last night initiated a week of freshman registration, orientation, and academic
placement testing. On Tuesday there will be a special assembly for resident students
on "This is Newport and Rhode Island," and on Friday they will tour Newport by bus.
An invitation picnic sponsored by Providence College at Lincoln Woods Saturday will
conclude the orientation week activities.

The 203 freshmen this fall compares
with last year's 241. They were selected from over 1000 applicants.

Registration for upper classes
will begin Friday and Saturday, September 17 and 18. All classes start Monday,
September 20.
