**SALVE REGINA COLLEGE BUS SERVICE
PROVIDENCE-NEWPORT**

The Salve Regina College bus will resume service on September 20, Monday of the first full week of school. The bus is a large blue and white one with a large sign clearly marked "Salve Regina College," operated by the Shore Line Bus Company.

There will be two buses on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays, but only one bus on Wednesdays. These buses will leave from the West Warwick garage of the company. One of the buses will reach the Providence Bus Terminal each school day at 7:30 a.m. Daily, except Wednesdays, a second bus will arrive at Fatima Hospital in time to leave from there at 7:15, and the Providence Bus Terminal at 7:30.

From the Providence Bus Terminal, the bus will proceed over the Washington Bridge, up Warren Avenue, and will turn on Pawtucket Avenue, arriving at St. Mary Academy, Bay View, at 7:45. The bus route from there depends upon the location of regular commuters beyond this point. Students from Barrington, Riverside, East Providence, Warren and Bristol may take the bus at Bay View the first day, and then arrange with the driver for the nearest convenient place for them to board the bus thereafter. The bus may be stopped at any point along the route outlined, although the best places are at the regularly scheduled bus stops for commercial buses.

One bus will return to Providence at 4 p.m. daily. On Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays, the other bus will leave for Providence at 5 p.m. to accommodate students at late classes. Further information may be obtained from the Business Office in the College's main building, Ochre Court.
