At the first annual meeting of the New England Council of Higher Education for Nursing held at the M. I. T. Faculty Club, last week, Sister Mary Augustine San Souci, R.S.M., was elected chairman to serve for a two-year period. Sister Mary Augustine is Director, Division of Nursing, Salve Regina College, Newport, Rhode Island.

N. E. C. H. N. is a council which was organized by the New England Board of Higher Education in recognition of the need for a broad approach to the improvement of nursing care through nursing education. The Council serves as a means whereby interstate, interinstitutional, and interagency cooperation in nursing education for the improvement of nursing practice shall be promoted.

Membership in the Council is comprized of delegates from colleges and universities located in the New England region, which have programs leading to associate, baccalaureate, or graduate degrees in nursing.
