JESUIT FOLK SINGER TO  
ENTERTAIN AT SALVE REGINA

Paul Guinlan, S. J., a Jesuit

seminarian of Weston, Massachusetts, and a nationally known folk singer, will give a concert for the students of Salve Regina College on Thursday, November 4 at 7:00 p.m. in the Great Hall of Ochre Court.

Mr. Guinlan's application of folk music style to liturgical music, especially to the Psalms, has won him wide acclaim. He has appeared in the last year at dozens of colleges and at both Catholic and Protestant seminaries.

The American Record Society has recently released an album of his songs under the title, "GLORY BOUND--Psalms Set To Folk Music."

On Thursday afternoon between 4:30 and 5:30 o'clock, Paul Guinlan will be available in the College's Bookstore in the basement of Wiley Hall, Narragansett and Ochre Point Avenues, to autograph the record albums which may be purchased at that time by interested individuals both from the student body and from the general public.
