SALVE REGINA COLLEGE RECEIVES
\$50,000 GRANT FOR SCHOLARSHIPS

Sister Mary Emily, R.S.M.,
president of Salve Regina College, announced today that the College had
recently received a grant of \$50,000 from Mr. Robert Goelet who died
in New York City this week.

Mr. Goelet was a great benefac-
tor of the College, his wife and he having donated Ochre Court, the College's
first and major building, to the Diocese of Providence in 1947, making
the establishment of Salve Regina College possible.

Over the years, Mr. Goelet had
annually donated a scholarship in honor of his late wife, Roberta Willard
Goelet. The \$50,000 gift has funded this scholarship so that it may be
granted each year in perpetuity.
