The Salve Regina College bus will resume service on September 19, Monday in the first full week of school. The bus is blue and white with a large sign clearly marked "Salve Regina College." It is operated by the Shore Line Bus Company, of 25 River Street, West Warwick, Rhode Island.

The bus leaves from the West Warwick garage of the company and reaches the Providence Bus Terminal each school day at 7:25 a.m. It then proceeds over the Washington Bridge, up Warren Avenue, and turns on Pawtucket Avenue, arriving at St. Mary Academy, Bay View, at 7:40. The bus route from there depends upon the location of regular commuters beyond this point. Students from Barrington, Riverside, and East Providence might take the bus at Bay View. On the first day, they can arrange with the bus driver for the nearest convenient place for them to board the bus thereafter. Warren and Bristol commuters can make similar arrangements. The bus may be stopped at any point along the route outlined, although the best places are at the regularly scheduled bus stops for commercial buses. The bus returns to Providence at 4 p.m. daily. A special schedule for nursing students residing at Fatima Hospital will be announced later.

Tickets are available in the Business Office. Students who are paying by the semester should come to the Office on the first day of attendance to get their tickets. Occasional users of the bus should buy their tickets at the Business Office. One-ride tickets are \$1.10. Books of ten tickets are \$7.50.
