**SUMMER SESSION AT SALVE
REGINA COLLEGE OPENS**

The 20th annual session of the Salve Regina College Summer School opened this morning, Monday, June 26, with registration at Mercy Hall for some 200 students.

Eighteen courses, a workshop, and a pre-college study skills for high school Juniors and Seniors program are being offered.

The summer session student body includes lay men and women college students who will be transferring their credits to such colleges as Rhode Island School for Design, Rhode Island College, Holy Cross, Boston University College of Liberal Arts, Eastern Michigan University, Stonehill College, College of Sante Fe, Southeastern Mass. Technical Institute, Roger Williams Junior College, and Rhode Island Junior College.

Sisters of Mercy of the Province of Providence and Sisters of other religious orders from twenty cities in Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont, Massachusetts, Rhode Island, Connecticut, New York, and New Jersey complete the summer school enrollment.

Classes will meet daily through August 4.
