Salve Regina Glee Club will join with St. Michael's College Glee Club of Winooski, Vermont in a concert on Saturday, November 18 at Ochre Court on the Salve Regina campus. The program will begin at 8:15 p.m. and is open to the general public with tickets on sale at \$1.50 and \$.75 (student price).

Since 1964, under the direction of Marian W. Van Slyke (Mrs. W. Harold) Salve Regina College Glee Club has expanded rapidly in repetoire and performances. The group of fifty women has presented joint concerts with Fordham University, Boston College, Peloquin Chorale, and the Choir of Our Lady of Providence Seminary.

Mrs. Van Slyke holds a degree from Eastman
School of Music of the University of Rochester and is minister of music of the First Baptist
Church of Fall River, Mass. She has organized and directs an Interfaith Choir of the Greater
Fall River Council of Churches and is a member of the American Guild of Organists.

The Gee Club of St. Michael's College is under the direction of Dr. William Tortolano, Music Director at the Vermont college. Dr. Tortolano is a Providence native and holds degrees from Boston University and the New England Conservatory of Music. The St. Michael's group consists of seventy-five voices and has given concerts in all New England states.
