The Salve Regina College Glee Club has a full itinerary of entertainment for the school year of 1968-1969, beginning with a combined concert on November 23rd in the Great Hall, Ochre Court, featuring St. John's University Glee Club from Jamaica, New York

The traditional Christmas Candlelight Concert will take place on December 15th at 3:30 p.m. at Salve. On Tuesday, December 3rd, the Glee Club will sing with other groups for the dedication of the New Chancery Office Building of the Diocese in Providence. The Chorale, a small group from the Glee Club will present a Christmas program for the William Ellery Chapter, DAR, December 10th and at the U. S. Navy Hospital the week of December 16th.

The Glee Club will travel to New York for a return concert with St. John's University Glee Club on March 15th and come home to Salve in time for a joint concert with the Episcopal Theological College Choir affiliated with Harvard University on March 22nd in the Great Hall, Ochre Court. A performance will be presented at the Guild Tea on May 25th and the club will sing for the Baccalaureate Service in St. Mary's Church, Newport, June 1st.
