Dr. Fallon's presentation, to be followed by general discussion, is entitled "Toward Self Understanding." Dr. Fallon's talk is a special feature of a new Continuing Education Program in urban psychology and education supported in part by a grant from the State Department of Education. Dr. Fallon was formerly Provost of Nasson College, and has done research and training in rural and small urban developments.
