Salve Regina College announced that two Resource Faculty have been added to the Psychology Department. Dr. Ismail Ersevim has been appointed to the Psychology Department as Adjunct Associate Clinical Professor of Psychology and Dr. Frank Gatti as Adjunct Assistant Clinical Professor of Psychology. Dr. Ersevim obtained his M.S. and M.D. degrees at the Istanbul University in Turkey. Dr. Gatti, a Ph. D. candidate, obtained his A.B. degree at Columbia University and his M.D. degree at Northwestern University.

Dr. Lester Carr, professor and Chairman of the Psychology Department indicated that the appointment of Dr. Ersevim and Dr. Gatti to Resource Faculty would help to carry out an interdisciplinary approach and provide a community orientation.
