Salve Regina College will conduct a curriculum workshop for its faculty on September 2, 3, and 4.

Dr. Paul L. Dressel, Director of Institutional Research, Assistant Provost and Professor of University Research at Michigan State University will give a series of talks at the workshop.

The workshop will open each day with a general meeting of all faculty members after which the faculty will breakdown into small panels for workshop discussion sessions of possible changes in the curriculum at the college.

Dr. Dressel has been a consultant to numerous colleges and universities on problems of research and curriculum development. He has written many articles in higher education journals and books on curriculum, two of which are: College and University Curriculum and the Undergraduate Curriculum in Higher Education.

The workshop will be a basis for the discussions of the aims of Salve Regina College and is another attempt at the continuing revaluation at the college in order to keep the college, curriculum and students abreast with the times.
