Newport, R. I. -- Salve Regina College by the sea has opened for its 26th academic year with an enrollment of 555 undergraduates, including 116 freshmen and transfer students.

The class of 1976, representing eight states, are already working toward baccalaureate degrees in twelve major fields, ranging from creative arts and French to medical technology and nursing.

One of nine Catholic colleges conducted by the Sisters of Mercy of the Union in this country, Salve Regina is a four-year, fully accredited liberal arts college for women. The College, founded in 1947, is situated on a 50-acre campus high above the Atlantic Ocean on Newport's historic peninsula.

Among the new freshmen at Salve Regina
