Gregory E. Zeitlin, principal flute with the Rhode Island Philharmonic Orchestra and visiting lecturer and artist in residence at Salve Regina College, will perform Sunday evening, September 24, at Ochre Court, on the Newport campus, at 8:00 p.m.

Accompanying Mr. Zeitlin will be Linda M. Ellison, pianist, a native of Portland, Oregon, who is currently teaching piano at Brown University and Rhode Island College.

A graduate of the Juilliard Institute of Musical Art, Mr. Zeitlin has also studied with Arthur Schwaner of the New Haven Symphony, George Barrere of Juilliard, Arthur Lora and Frederick Wilkins. He is presently continuing study with Julius Baker, principal flute of the New York Philharmonic.

He is teaching at Salve Regina in the newly expanded Community Music Program, under the direction of the Creative Arts division of the College. He is also teaching at Rhode Island College, the University of Rhode Island and Rhode Island Junior College.
