Salve Regina College, Newport, R. I., will honor its retiring president, Sister Mary Christopher, R.S.M., Saturday, May 12, 1973, with a number of special events on campus.

At 2:00 p.m., the Young People's Symphony of Rhode Island, under the direction of Dr. Joseph Conte, will present a Pops Concert at "Wakehurst," a benefit performance for the College and a Salute to Sister Mary Christopher.

The Concert in the "Wakehurst" Gardens will feature 65 young musicians.
