Sept. 16 -- One hundred seventy-eight freshmen were welcomed to Salve Regina College this morning by Sister Mary Rosalia, R.S.M., Dean of Studies. They come from near and far -- 18 from Newport, 7 from Middletown, 2 from Portsmouth, 1 from Jamestown, and 3 from Tiverton -- with one from as far west as California.

The 105 resident students arrived last night and were assigned to their dormitories at the college.

Registration procedures were explained and each student's schedule for the orientation testing program was worked out. The students were also addressed by Sister Mary Donald, R.S.M., Dean of Women. The theme of today's session was "This is Salve Regina College."

Later in the week there will be a special assembly for resident freshmen on the topic, "This is Newport," with a film furnished by the Newport Chamber of Commerce.

Social events will include a Barbecue on Ocean Terrace, Wednesday, and an Informal Dance in Mercy Hall on Friday.

Sophomore, Junior, and Senior Registration will be held Thursday and Friday.

The 178 freshmen this fall compares with last year's 120.
