Dr. Thomas H. D. Mahoney, Associate

Humanities Professor of History at Massachusetts Institute of Technology, will speak at Salve Regina College's annual formal Honors Convocation and Capping of Nursing Students to be held on the Terrace of Ochre Court, the college's main building, this afternoon at 2 o'clock.

The Right Reverend Monsignor James V.

Greene, Pastor of St. Mary's Church, Newport, will preside at the ceremony, attended by faculty, students, parents and guests.

The honored students are those sophomores, juniors and seniors who attained high academic standing in the 1962-63 college year. Sister Mary Augustine, R.S.M., Director of the Nursing Division, will present caps to 19 sophomore and 3 junior nursing students. Their senior sisters will conclude the capping ceremony.

Dr. Mahoney, who will speak on "The Catholic Woman's College and the World of the 'Sixties'," previously lectured at Salve Regina during the 1959 winter lecture series on "Communism or Christianity."

A well known author and lecturer.

Dr. Mahoney has studied at Boston College, The George Washington University, Harvard and Georgetown. His memberships include the American Historical Association, the Catholic Historical Association and the Catholic Commission on Cultural and Intellectual affairs.
