HOME ECONOMICS AND POLITICAL SCIENCE MEETINGS**

Sister Mary Joannes, R.S.M., of Salve Regina College's Home Economics Department, will attend an "Open House" at The Massachusetts General Hospital in Boston, Friday, December 13.

Those present will be faculty members of New England Colleges and universities which prepare students for dietetic internships.

Salve Regina College offers two areas of concentration in Home Economics, general home economics and foods and nutrition. Students are prepared for teaching, home making, demonstration work, and dietetic internships under American Dietetic Association sponsorship.

Earlier in the week, Sister Mary Wilhelmina, R.S.M., of the History Department, met with representatives of the eight Rhode Island Colleges who share in the Political Internship Program sponsored by Senator Claiborne Pell. The meeting was held at the University Club, Brown University.

Salve Regina College had two students participate in the program in 1963, and the same quota has been assigned for 1964. This offers the participants a full week's experience in the Senator's Washington Office. The Salve Regina representatives will probably be in Washington in early March.
