by Henry G. Chapman); "Mass in Time of War" (Second Mass in C) by J. Haydn; and
"Battle Hymn of the Republic," arranged by Peter J. Wilhousky.

Regina College Glee Club are: "Father William" (words by Lewis Carroll, music by Irving
Fine); "Lift Thine Eyes to the Mountains" from Mendelssohn's "Elijah"; "Bread Baking"
by Bela Bartok; "Barbara Allen" (a mountain ballad by Ron Nelson); and "The Heavens
Declare," arranged by C. Alexander Peloquin.

The Fordham Glee Club will sing:
"Haec Dies" by Gallus; Peeters' "Sing to the Lord;" Debussy's "Invocation;" "A Mighty
