SALVE REGINA COLLEGE PROFESSOR
TO SPEAK AT FALL RIVER CONVENTION

Dr. Ascanio G. DiPippo,

Assistant Professor of Chemistry, Salve Regina College, will speak at the annual convention of the Catholic Teachers Association of the Diocese of Fall River on May 6, 1965 at 3:30 p.m.

The convention is being held at the Bishop Feehan High School, Attleboro, Massachusetts. Dr. DiPippo will speak on the topic "Radiant Energy Transfer."

Dr. DiPippo has his B.S., M.S., and Ph.D. degrees from the University of Rhode Island and has done post-doctoral research at the University of Colorado, where he will be again this summer. He is a member of the American Chemical Society, Sigma Xi, Phi Kappa Phi, and Phi Sigma.
