The Salve Regina and Mother of Mercy Praesidia of the Salve Regina College Legion of Mary will sponsor a cook-out tomorrow (Saturday, May 14) on the grounds of Mercy Hall from 2 to 5 p. m. Entertainment, consisting of a marionette show and group singing will precede the cook-out.

Tickets may be purchased from Legion of Mary members at \$1 and the proceeds will be sent to the New York Senatus' Peregrinatio Program through the Newport Curia of the Legion of Mary.

The New York Senatus of the Legion of Mary has planned a summer program for Legionaries and others who may be interested in apostolic work, in several places where such a program will be helpful. Among these places are: Norton, Virginia; Hogansburg, Albion, Hudson Falls, and Lake Luzerne, New York; St. Thomas the Apostle Church, and the Bowery, New York City; and British Honduras and Mexico.

Work in these places will be typical Legion of Mary work: instructions, preparation for sacraments, census taking, camp work with children of migrant works, work with the Mohawk Indians on their reservation, street apostolic work, home visitation, etc.
