NURSING INSTITUTE AT SALVE REGINA COLLEGE

Registration was held this morning, June 9, at Miley Hall on the campus of Salve Regina College, Newport, for the Institute for Hospital Nurses in Leadership Positions. The Institute, conducted by the College's Division of Nursing with a grant from the United States Public Health Service, will run from June 9 through June 15.

The purpose of the Institute is to assist professional nurse practitioners to increase their understanding and knowledge of effective and efficient techniques, principles, and methods for managing the nursing care of hospitalized patients.

Sister Mary Augustine, R.S.M., Director of the Division of Nursing, Salve Regina College, is Program Director.

Fifty nurses from Maine, Vermont, Massachusetts, Rhode Island, Connecticut, New York, New Jersey, and Illinois will be in attendance.
