AVAILABLE AT SALVE REGINA COLLEGE
THIS SUMMER

A course in creative writing for those interested in the study and practice of the techniques of verse, the short story, and the one-act play will be offered in the Salve Regina Summer Session, daily from 10:30 to 11:45 a.m., Monday through Friday, June 28 to August 6. The teacher will be Miss Mary Zavada, who has studied at the College of St. Elizabeth, De Paul University, New York University, Breadloaf School of English, Catholic University of America, and the University of London.

Her most recent experience before joining the Salve Regina faculty last fall included two years of lecturing in creative writing and contemporary literature at Trinity College in Washington, D.C., and a summer as a feature writer for United Press International in London.

From July 6 to 30, a four weeks seminar of creative art will be offered at Salve Regina. This will include painting--oil, landscape, mixed media; ceramics--pottery, wheel, hand; and arts and crafts. The seminar will be staffed by Sister Mary Mercedes, R.S.M., head of the Art Department at the College, Mr. Martin Murray (painting) and Mr. Charles Laranjo (ceramics).

These courses are open not only to teachers but to anyone who would like to spend four or six weeks this summer in a cultural and creative activity and atmosphere. Further information may be had by telephoning the College.
