**SALVE REGINA COLLEGE HOLDS FIFTH ANNUAL
SUMMER COMMENCEMENT WITH 31 GRADUATES**

Thirty-one Sisters of Mercy today,
Thursday, August 5, received the degree of Bachelor of Arts from Salve Regina
College at the College's fifth annual summer commencement.

The Most Reverend Bernard M.
Kelly, D.D., J.C.D., Auxiliary Bishop of Providence, presided at the exercises
held at 3:00 p.m. on the Terrace of Ochre Court and delivered the commencement
address.

Candidates for degrees were presented
by Sister Mary Rosalia, R.S.M., dean, and the degrees were conferred by
Sister MaryEmily, R.S.M., president.

Greetings from the Rhode Island
Department of Education were conveyed by Dr. William P. Robinson, Jr., Com-
missioner of Education, who also presented statements of eligibility for teaching
to the graduates.

Today's event brings to a conclusion--
with the exception of a Space Science Workshop to be held August 16-27--the largest
summer school program ever offered by Salve Regina College. Twenty under-
graduate courses, two workshops--including one for professional nurses, and
an art seminar will have involved over 250 students by the end of the month.
