FIVE SALVE STUDENTS NAMED OUTSTANDING ATHLETES

Five students from Salve Regina College, Newport, R. I., have been named "Outstanding College Athletes of America," according to an announcement today by Dr. Ascanio G. DiPippo, director of athletics.

The award is made annually to men and women athletes for "exceptional contributions to the athletic programs of their colleges," and for meeting "the ideals of sportsmanship and leadership." Also considered in determining the award winners are the academic record and campus and community activities of each nominee.

The award-winning athletes from Salve Regina are: Sheila Kissane of Hartford, Conn., (basketball); Elizabeth von Trapp of Adamsville, R. I., (cross country); Deborah Camarata of North Fairfield, Conn., (cross country); Clay Jones of Newport, R. I., (basketball); and Ray Walker of Newport, R. I., (basketball). They were selected from among hundreds of nominees throughout the country.

Dr. DiPippo termed the selection of the five Salve students an "excellent tribute to the athletic and academic achievements of each winner." He also added that the comparatively large
